Empowers Black mothers currently involved in, and at-risk for, their children's involvement in the child welfare system, with support to achieve economic independence, security, and mobility, and equips them with the skills necessary to navigate DC's complex legal, criminal, and foster care systems.



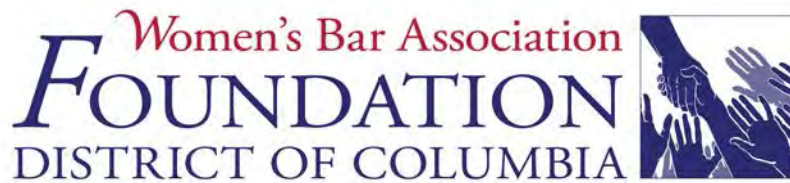
SAFE SISTERS CIRCLE

The Community Lawyer Initiative provides on-site legal services and traveling legal clinics to deliver legal representation to Black women survivors of domestic and sexual violence living primarily in Wards 7 and 8.



VOLARE

The DV LEAP program is a leader in survivor appellate advocacy; attorneys challenge unjust trial outcomes by litigating appeals, filing Amicus briefs, and fighting for survivor rights all the way to the Supreme Court.
