Maximizing the reach and impact of WBAF sponsor funds community-wide, the WBAF carefully evaluates and thoughtfully funds multiple community-focused nonprofit organizations that provide essential services for local women or girls. The WBAF's grantees consist of an array of organizations: some large and well-known, others are smaller grassroots start-ups. AMARA LEGAL CENTER

supporting survivors of sex trafficking with civil legal services, including civil protection orders, child custody, divorce, sealing and vacating criminal records, and victimwitness advocacy.



AYUDA – supporting the Client Support and Empowerment Fund, which provides culturally-specific legal services for immigrant girls and women who are victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking, as well as abused, abandoned, and neglected children.



DC KINCARE ALLIANCE -

supporting the Legal Defense Project, which provides legal help to relative caregivers to obtain the rights, benefits, and services needed to ensure a safe and stable home for the at-risk DC children they raise.



DC VOLUNTEER LAWYERS PROJECT -

supporting clinics that serve women and other survivors of domestic and gender-based violence by providing legal assistance and advocacy on victim legal rights in housing, employment, and financial matters.



FIRST SHIFT JUSTICE PROJECT

- supporting efforts to provide employment-related direct legal services to low-income women in DC.

MIL MUJERES - supporting efforts to increase the level of legal representation that is available to Latina immigrants in DC, particularly survivors of domestic violence, human trafficking, sexual assault, and other violent crimes.



MOTHER'S OUTREACH

NETWORK – supporting a pop-up legal clinic program focused on mothers with children entangled in the child welfare/family regulation system that provides assistance navigating investigations and hearings, as well as advocacy services including those supporting economic security.



NETWORK FOR VICTIM RECOVERY OF DC – supporting the Systemic Advocacy Legal Services and Pro Bono Program, through which NVRDC builds partnership with law firms to combat barriers survivors face in accessing justice and to provide other services.




THE SAFE SISTERS CIRCLE -

supporting the East of the River Women's Legal Services Project, which provides free legal services to Black women survivors of domestic and sexual violence living in Wards 7 and 8, and providing educational workshops for clients on making safe choices regarding their relationships, consent in sexual situations, and reproductive opportunities/justice.



TZEDEK DC – supporting the provision of trauma-informed legal assistance for women subject to financial abuse and coerced debt.
